

## **(Minor) Committee Restructure of Spring 2017**

Councillor evaluations and the feedback of committee chairs shaped the recommendations of the Governance Committee to the AMS Council of 2017-2018. All committees would have, if the recommendations are adopted, 7 members, but with varying amounts of executives, councillors (defined as non-executive councillors) and members at large. The changes have been recommended as opposed to actual code changes in order to avoid changing the Code and then having the new Council reverse some/all of those changes. The Council of 2017-2018 will need to ensure that all positions on committees of Council, in addition to committees external to the Society to which members are appointed, are filled; as such, changes to these numbers or other provisions in the Code (such as how many members from a constituency make hold appointments to a certain committee, for example) may be necessary. For reference, Council appoints 29 members internally and 20 externally (both numbers for executives and non-executive councillors).

### **Governance Committee**

Adjust composition to 1 member at large, 5 councillors and 1 executive.

### **Student Life Committee**

Adjust composition to 1 member at large, 4 councillors and 2 executives. The Student Life Committee interacts with the Blue and Gold Society, and so the voice of the student body is maintained through this channel.

### **Operations Committee**

Adjust composition to 2 members at large, 4 councillors and 1 executive.

### **Advocacy Committee**

Adjust composition to 1 member at large, 4 councillors and 2 executives.

### **Human Resources**

Adjust composition to 1 member at large, 5 councillors and 1 executive.

### **Finance Committee**

Retain composition as 2 members at large, 3 councillors and 2 executives.
