## Position Purpose

The Transit and U-Pass Commissioner will assist the Vice President External Affairs with transit related research and lobbying efforts. The Commissioner will also assist with gauging student interest, concerns about the U-Pass, transit access, affordability, etc.

  - i.e. create dedicated bus lanes, housing policy, etc

- Attend U-Pass meetings with VP External, where necessary
- Work closely with the University and Government Relations Advisor
- Respond to all UPASS inquiries from students
- Works with the AMS mission statement and values to operate a successful department
- Other duties as required
