BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council suspend Code Section II, Article 17 (9,10) for the purpose of allowing Council to recognize the Vancouver School of Economics Undergraduate Society (VSEUS) without requiring VSEUS to hold a second referendum on whether they should be the organization to represent the students of the Vancouver School of Economics.
