



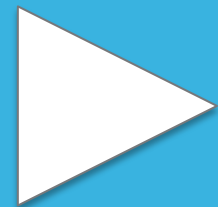
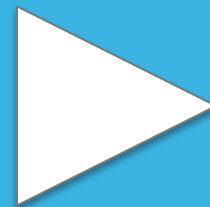

BASIC DETAILS

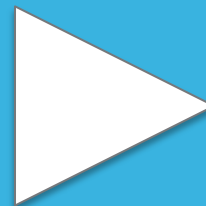
- New elections timeline structure – additional two weeks was nice for preparation – but possibly caused additional drop-outs?

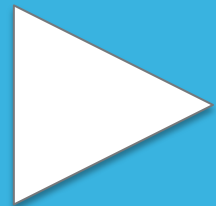
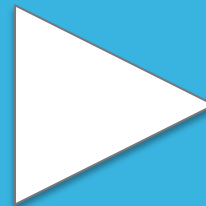

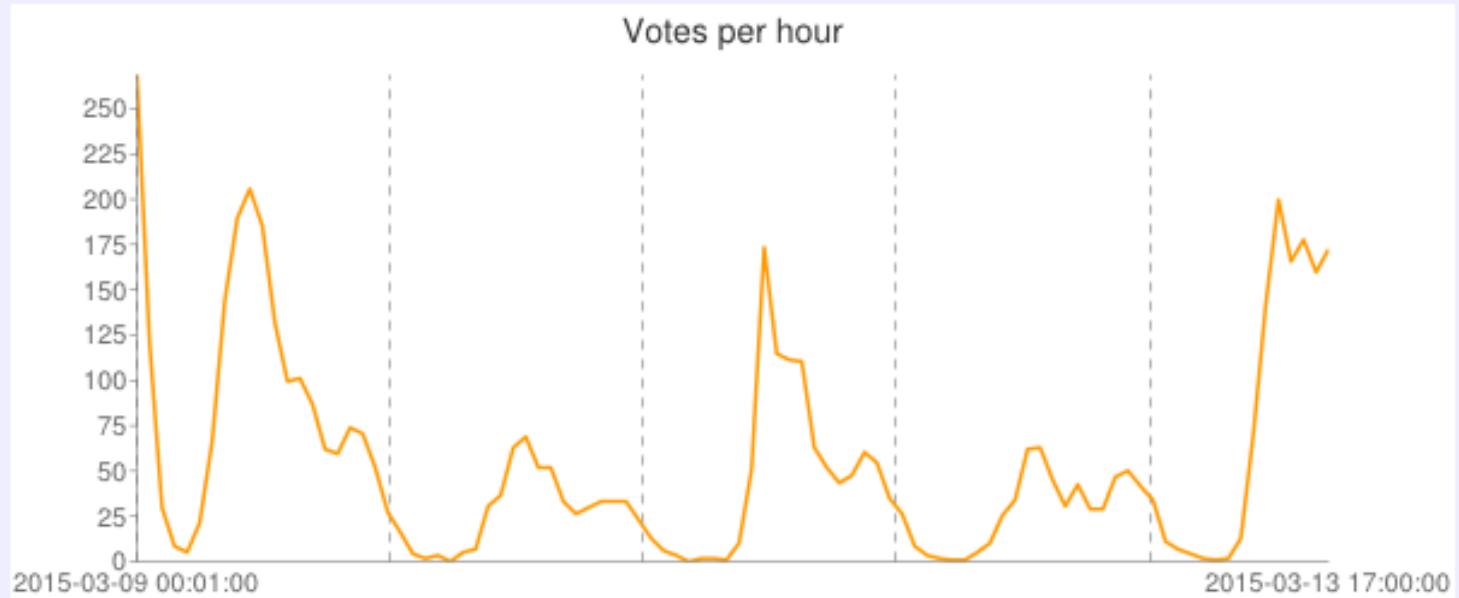
TURNOUT

- 6155 votes cast
- 12.9% voter turnout
- Comparison:
 - 2014 – 22.4%,
 - 2013 – 43.9%,
 - 2012 – 11.6%,
 - 2011 – 11.9%
 - This election year totally absent of referenda
- Abstention average of **22.3%**

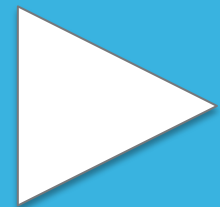
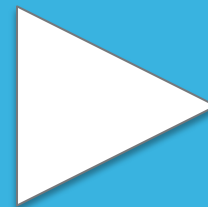


TURNOUT

Turnout Chart (6155 electors voted)

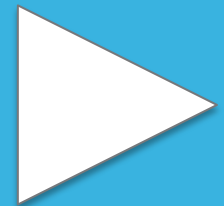
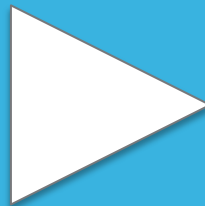


- Increasing complaints surrounding mail blasts.



VOTER IRREGULARITY

- 2AM on Friday March 13 → informed of graduated students being able to vote,
- Irregularity was noticed as those who graduated in Term 1 still having the ballot open to them,
- Turned out this was the result of miscommunications over the definition of an “AMS Member” in past years, although those who were only enrolled in courses in Term 1 could not vote in 2014W election.



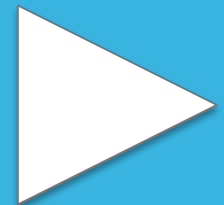
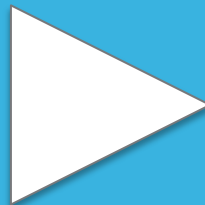
IRREGULARITY: MEMBER DEFINITION

From Bylaws:

ACTIVE MEMBERS

Active members shall be those persons who are not in default of payment of the fees of the Society, as determined in accordance with Bylaw 14, and who:

- i) are **enrolled in a degree or diploma program** administered by UBC Vancouver or an Affiliated Institution; or
- ii) are **registered in a credit course**; or
- iii) were registered in a **credit course on the last day of March** of the current Academic Year.

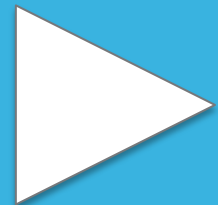
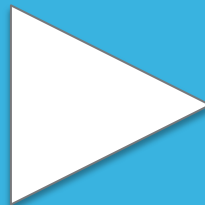


IRREGULARITY: MEMBER DEFINITION

The voters identified were:

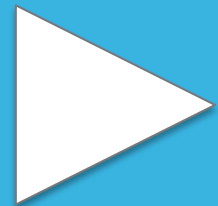
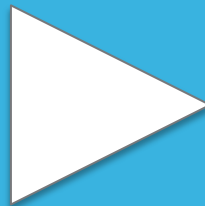
- No longer enrolled in a degree or diploma program
- Not currently enrolled in a credit course
- Not subject to the clause re: registration on the last day in March

Thus, these votes were deemed illegitimate.



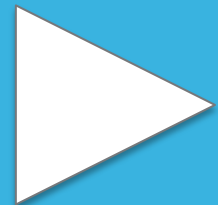
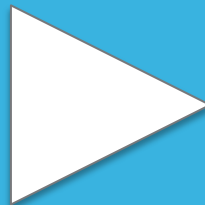
IRREGULARITY: RECTIFICATION

- **Early morning** – Worked with Todd in UBC IT to deliver a list of voters who met the criteria that would deem them **ineligible** as previously defined. We were able to pull a list including their **associated unique voter ID's**.
- **2:00PM** – Phone meeting with Brian from SimplyVoting to determine best course of action. Decided to **attempt to discard ineligible votes from system**.
- **3:30PM** – UBC IT confirmed that they would be able to pull the segmented voters from the list and discard their votes.
- **4:55PM** – Server command is run and **votes are discarded**.



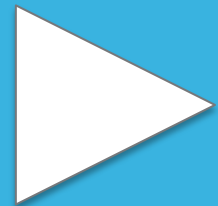
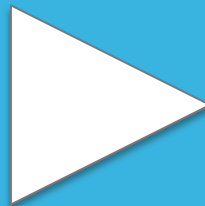
IRREGULARITY: RESULTS

- UBC IT was requested to keep temporary data files associated with deleted electors so that a **separate results sheet could be tabulated,**
- **In total, 83 votes were discarded.**



IRREGULARITY: RESULTS

Inclusion of the votes would not have impacted the outcome of any of the electoral races.
