Please take this as notice that the following referendum of the Engineering Undergraduate Society, a constituency of the Alma Mater Society of UBC Vancouver, is adopted as proposed and that quorum is met with 12.9% of 4827 electors participating. The results and wording of the question are below for your review, taken from the SimplyVoting system, for voting dates March 18-22, 2019.

Turnout: 623 (12.9%) of 4827 electors voted in this ballot.

EDTAC Referendum

The EUS Council has called for the following question to be posed through a referendum of the Society:

Do you approve the temporary addition of \$2 to the Engineering Undergraduate Society (EUS) fee to be first assessed in September 2019 and to be assessed annually thereafter until it's final assessment in September 2023 that would support the UBC Engineering Design Teams Advisory Council (EDTAC)?
