Administrative History

The idea of student self-government at the University of British Columbia was realized in the fall of 1915 during a meeting of the student body at which time Sherwood Lett was elected as the first president of the Alma Mater Society (AMS). In the summer of 1915, a provisional constitution for the Society was drafted. Every student becomes a member of the AMS upon enrolment in a credit course at UBC and the payment of the AMS fee. In working toward its mission of improving the quality of the educational, social and personal lives of UBC students, the AMS administers resource groups, campus businesses and over two hundred clubs. Politically, the Society has the mandate to represent the student body to the University administration, to federal and provincial governments and to society in general. The AMS is governed by a 45 member Student Council consisting of the Executive (President, Vice President, and Directors of Administration, Finance, and External Affairs), and representatives from undergraduate societies and schools, student representatives from the Board of Governors, UBC Senate and the Graduate Society and the AMS Ombudsperson. The AMS Executive, Senate and Board of Governors representatives are elected by the general student population each January.

Custodial History

The records of the Alma Mater Society have been transferred to the University Archival in several accessions since 1972. Since 1983, the bulk of the records have arranged and described by AMS archives staff before being transferred. Some items in the Early Records series (boxes 96 and 98) were found in the basement of the Mathematics Building in 1994 and added to the fonds.

Scope and Content

The fonds consists of records documenting the full scope of the activities of the Alma Mater Society arranged in the following series: constitution and by-laws and codes of procedure (1916-1990), governance (1921-1992), subject files / central files (1931-1994), early records (1916-1933), correspondence (1986-1992), and records relating to student housing (1952-1992). Also included is the Arts Collection sous-fonds (1955-1998) and the Programs Office sous-fonds (1975-2001).

Notes

Title based on the contents of the fonds.

344 slides which document UBC P.N.E. Open House (1961), Clubs Day Open House (1961), Open House 1963, 1970) have been added to the Slide Collection (in UBC Historical Photographs) under the number 36.1.

The reel-to-reel audio tape is an undated recording of a meeting with Swimton and Company representatives to discuss liability for the centre beam failure in the Thunderbird Winter Sports Centre. This tape has been added to the Audio Recordings as UBC 2261.

Series Descriptions

Constitution, By-Laws and Code of Procedure Series. -- 1916-1990.

55 cm of textual records.

The series consists of copies of the A.M.S. constitution, by-laws and codes of procedure, as well as drafts, amendments and revisions over time.

Governance Series. -- 1921-1992.

4.75 m of textual records.

The series consists of minutes and associated documentation received or generated in the course of administering the A.M.S.

Subject Files / Central Files Series. – 1931-1994.

27.23 m of textual records.

The series consists of separate sets of alphabetical subject files for the periods 1931-1975 (boxes 9-68), 1976-1986 (boxes 69-87), 1986/87 (boxes 99-101), 1987/88 (boxes 101-103), 1988/89 (boxes 105-109), 1990-1992 (boxes 113-116), and 1992-1994 (boxes 139-146). This series documents the full range of A.M.S. activities and responsibilities and, as such, includes records of its various committees and student clubs, its relationships with outside organizations, and the A.M.S.'s involvement in Brock Hall, Student Union Building, Aquatic Centre, War Memorial Gym and Thunderbird Winter Sports Centre.

A.M.S. Early Records Series. – 1918-1933.

79 cm of textual records.

The series consists of miscellaneous minutes, correspondence reports and financial records received in a number of small accessions which document some of the early history of the A.M.S.

Correspondence Series. -- 1986-1992.

56 cm of textual records.

The series consists of correspondence generated by various officers of the A.M.S. Correspondence prior to 1986 appears in the alphabetical subject files.

Miscellaneous – Housing Series. – 1952-1992.

33.2 cm of textual records.

The series consists of records relating to the issue of student housing.

Sous-fonds Descriptions

Art Collection Sous-Fonds. – 1955-1998.

90 cm of textual records.

The Alma Mater Society Art Collection was started in 1948, with the purchase of E.J. Hughes' painting, *Abandoned Village*. In 1955, the Student Council provided a grant for the collection and created a committee to administer it. The committee was briefly known as the Canadian Art Committee, but soon changed its name to the Brock Hall Art Committee. The AMS Bylaws were amended in 1956 to make provision for annual funding for the collection. The collection was greatly expanded in 1958, when *Maclean's* magazine donated nine paintings that had been commissioned for a special issue on British Columbia's centennial. The Brock Hall Art Committee maintained and expanded the art collection until 1969, when the Art Collection moved into the recently completed Student Union Building. At this point, the committee name was changed to the AMS Art Gallery Committee, and the responsibility for exhibitions in the new SUB Art Gallery was added to its functions. In 1973, the Art Gallery Committee was split into two committees: the SUB Art Gallery Committee, which was to maintain the collection and expand it, and the AMS Art Gallery Programs Committee, which was to focus solely on exhibitions in the Gallery. In 1976, after the creation of the Student Administrative Commission (SAC), the Art Gallery committees were placed under SAC's supervision. In 1984, according to a history of the art collection written in 1986, the two Art Committees were recombined into the AMS Art Gallery Committee. However, the AMS Code of Procedure did not recognize the recombining until 1990, and there remains some confusion concerning the chronology of the various committees.

The records consist primarily of correspondence and documents from the various committees, concerning the artwork in the art collection. In addition, there are biographies and articles from both the popular and the art media for many of the artists represented in the collection. The records include files on individual artists; general files for artists who do not have individual files; files for the various committees, consisting mostly of minutes of meetings and correspondence with the University and the AMS; and files containing materials on the specifics of maintaining and expanding an art collection, loans to other galleries, exhibitions in the SUB Art Gallery and finances.

AMS Programs Offices Sous-fonds. – 1975-2001.

5.5 m of textual records.

The Programs Office (later the Programs Department and then the Events Department), the AMS department in charge of social activities, existed in various forms beginning as early as 1933, when social activities were put under the joint control of the Men's Undergraduate Society, the Women's Undergraduate Society, the Men's Athletic Association and the Women's Athletic Association. In 1949, this arrangement was changed and the AMS Coordinator of Activities assumed responsibility aided by a Coordination Committee. The Committee became the Special Events Committee, a standing committee of the Student Council sometime between 1949 and 1951. The Special Events Committee became the Programs Committee in 1978, and in 1979/80 became the Concerts Committee before becoming the Programs Committee again from 1980 through the mid-1990s. In 1996 the Programs Planning Group (PPG) was created to replace the Programs Committee. In 1999, the Student Activity Planning Group (SAPG) was created and assumed the functions of the Programs Planning Group. It was abolished in 2001.

The Programs Committee was responsible for organizing concerts, speakers and special events. According to the 1992 AMS Code of Procedure, its mandate was "to provide varying forms of musical, theatrical, and oratorical entertainment, 'first year' programming, and to oversee programs that are generally of interest to Society members." By 1982, a full-time staff position, known first as Programs Coordinator and later as the Programs Director and then the Events Manager, was created to oversee the Programs Department in conjunction with the Programs Committee.

The sous-fonds consists of operational and administrative records arising out of the work carried out by the AMS Programs Office.
