DESCRIPTION & RATIONALE

The President is recommending that the AMS Council approve the appointment processes for the Forestry Undergraduate Society (“FUS”), Dentistry Undergraduate Society (“DUS”), and Arts Undergraduate Society (“AUS”). Unfortunately, there was a confusion amongst these three constituencies regarding the election of their senators, and it resulted in no individuals being elected. After consulting with the respective constituencies, they have decided to fill the vacancies through an appointment as opposed to a special election. The FUS and DUS have elected to select their senators through an in-council appointment, similar to AMS Council appointing students-at-large to its committees. The AUS has decided to select their senators through an interview

process. The expectation is that these vacancies will be filled before the end of April.

The FUS is recommending to AMS Council that Chalaya Moonias be appointed as the Forestry Student Senator. Chalaya was selected through an in-council appointment by FUS.
