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**DESCRIPTION &  
RATIONALE**

With the transition of the Steering Committee to be more "Council Operations" focused (i.e on agenda setting, Committee Chair updates, goal setting, Council Orientation and socials) the relevance of discussion to students-at-large as become quite limited.

Applications to serve on the Steering Committee from students at large is also very limited, with total applicants usually totaling no more than one-third of what other Committees see.

These combined factors has led to the recommendation that the Student-at-large seat be removed from the Steering Committee and that the Committee continue to focus more strongly on Council coordination.
