### **Advocacy / Housing**

- Housing is planning a TRAC workshop, in partnership with SHCS, for first-year students to learn about their rental rights before leaving Residence to enter the Vancouver Housing market.

### **Food Bank**

- The ‘Add a Dollar’ campaign with F&B is in the process of wrapping up
- Despite being closed for Reading Week, February looks like it will be our busiest ever month.
- The Food Bank car (the former Safewalk Prius)’s battery has failed. We are continuing our conversations with UBC’s Fleet team about replacing the vehicle.
