Services

AMS Food Bank

- € Food Bank just completed a trial of a partnership with the Sikh Students' Association and GNFK to give out around 200 free meals in the Food Bank last Tuesday. Moving forward, this program will for the next few Tuesdays from 5:00 – 7:00 PM in the Food Bank. We would like to extend a big thank you to the teams at the Sikh Students Association for coming to us with this project and to the Guru Nanak Free Kitchen for preparing and providing the meals.

Advocacy

- € Advocacy usage numbers are a little bit slower this month, but we are busy preparing for exam season, which is always the busiest time of the term.
- € In addition to the standard academic misconduct cases, we are also seeing a number of cases involving the Centre for Accessibility.
