Executive Goals

- Office goals have been largely completed and include several goals related to housing affordability, expanding research opportunities, tuition, food security, academic policy changes, Campus Vision 2050, international student support, and more.

Academic Experience Survey

- For the first time in quite some time, we are creating Faculty-specific AES reports that break down even further responses to questions and provide Faculty-specific data for our advocacy that will be circulated to the respective Deans, Associate Deans, and constituency leaders.

Campus Vision 2050

- Provided several submissions articulating priorities, concerns, and questions related to the Land Use Plan and Housing Action Plan to the Campus Vision team.
- Preparing priorities related to the draft 30-year vision for the campus that will be available for consultation later this month and priorities for the 10-year campus plan which is part of the next phase of Campus Vision engagement.

Budget

- The brief on the UBC budget is out for consultation among certain constituency leaders and staff at the AMS, it will be broadly circulated once revisions based on that consultation are completed.

Academic Integrity

- Currently in talks with the Academic Integrity Hub to start planning for Academic Integrity Week as well as providing consultation on potential systemic improvements to the program and its delivery of services based on the results of the AES.

Student Affordability Task Force (SATF) Implementation

- Currently working with several leads responsible for the implementation of the SATF recommendations to ensure student priorities are reflected in next steps.
