Amendments to reintroduce oral reports to Council by the BoG and Senate reps (while retaining the written reports).

Additions are indicated by ***bold italics***. Deletions are indicated by striking through (~~this~~).

SECTION III: MEETINGS OF COUNCIL

Article 1. Rules of Order

17. (a) Short, succinct reports by the Board of Governors representatives and the Student Senators who sit as non-voting members of Council shall be submitted to Council for every Council meeting, preferably in point form and being no longer than one page. The Ombudsperson may also submit a report.
- (b) The reports shall be submitted in time for them to be circulated to members of Council at the same time as the agenda. Supplemental reports may be submitted later if necessary.
- ~~(c) Council members may ask questions of each of those reporting. No more than three (3) questions in total from all Councillors shall be allowed for each of these Reports.~~
- (c) ***During Board of Governors, Senate, and Ombudsperson Reports, one of the Board of Governors representatives and one of the Senators who sit as non-voting members of Council shall each speak for no more than three (3) minutes, elaborating on their submitted reports. The Ombudsperson may also make an oral report of no more than three (3) minutes. Councillors may then ask questions of each of those reporting. No more than three (3) questions in total from all Councillors shall be allowed for each report.***
