Undergraduate Research

- Proposal on undergraduate research has been endorsed by the Vice President Research and Innovation, Vice President Students Office, and Provost's Office and we are currently working with three Faculties to pilot the project.

Mental Health and Harm Reduction

- Working with the Student Health portfolio in the Vice President Students Office at UBC to investigate the potential of more fentanyl and drug testing sites on campus as well as campaigns and training related to Naloxone training and proactive mental health responses.

Budget

- In the preliminary stages of establishing AMS priorities for the UBC Budget consultation cycle which begins soon, consulting with various stakeholders.

Exam Database

- The idea of the database has been endorsed by the Vice President Students Office and the Provost's Office. Working to find funding sources and establish quotes on costs associated with development of databases.

Open Education Resources (OERs)

- Successfully secured the presentation of the OER Impact Award at the AMS OER Champions Night and looking at ways to improve this event/campaign at large.
- Working to improve the Textbook Broke Campaign by collaborating with the Provost's Office.

International Student Awards

- Working with the International Student Initiative to establish long term strategies in shaping International Student awards for the next several years.
