Advocacy

- € Advocacy is seeing an increased number of cases as compared to last month, and we expect a surge in cases around midterms.
- € We continue to see a steady stream of housing related cases, which tend to be relatively complex.
- € The Housing branch is planning a Know Your Rights workshop with TRAC later this month.

Safewalk

- € Safewalk usage is doing really well, with September seeing over 3 times as many interactions as September 2022. The team has been doing a great job keeping up with the increased volume.

Tutoring:

- € Tutoring programming is also doing well, with over twice as many interactions this September as September 2022.
- € Upcoming programming includes free LSAT review sessions in partnership with the Pre-Law Society, as well as a partnership with the VPAUA office for an Academic Resource Fair.

Food Bank

- € The Food Bank experienced its second busiest day of all time on Thursday, October 5th, in part as a result of closures on Mondays for holidays.
